

Title: All Therapy Ideas & Activities, Nothing Else, Nothing More!

Abstract:

This session is divided into two parts, the first focusing on articulation intervention and the second on language intervention. In the area of articulation, it offers various therapy ideas and activities for sound awareness and practice, for measuring progress, and for promoting carryover of learned skills. The language intervention portion focuses on important language skills necessary for social and academic success in children. The ideas and activities shared promote teaching through naturalistic and functional contexts, which is optimal for new learning. Participants walk away with fresh ideas for intervention sessions that are fun and keep children engaged and motivated.

Summary:

This session is divided into two parts, the first focusing on articulation intervention and the second on language intervention. Participants will be given practical activities that can be implemented easily and immediately with their caseloads, activities that yield positive results in the remediation of articulation disorders.

The language intervention portion focuses on important language skills necessary for social and academic success in children. The ideas and activities shared promote teaching through naturalistic and functional contexts, which is optimal for new learning. Important language targets that correlate with academic areas are highlighted, and SLPs are given meaningful activities that effectively address multiple language targets at once. Increasing frequency and intensity of language intervention through parent training and involvement is also discussed.

In all, participants walk away with fresh ideas for intervention sessions that are fun and keep children engaged and motivated.
